# REMIC

Brazil's health service infra-structure consists of government health services, which are offered by the Health Public System (simply known as SUS), and the private medical sector.

SUS was established in 1988 in order to guarantee free access to health care to the entire population and, until nowadays, a great part of Brazil's population have depended on it.

That is why it was so important when, in June 25th 2013, the government added the FM System as one of the access technologies provided by SUS. Following certain conditions, children and adolescents studying in regular schools can receive an FM System.

This website, initially known as the FM System Portal, was created to provide a source for continued education to Audiologists and to inform parents and teachers of FM System's users

It was the result of Audiologist Tacianne Kriscia Machado Alves's master's degree research at University of São Paulo (USP) for the SLP-Audiology Graduate Program. Ms. Alves's research was advised by Professor Regina Tangerino de Souza Jacob, Ph.D., with the assistance of the FAPESP development agency Process No. 2014 / 09718-4.

The international translation and cross-cultural adaptation of the FM System Portal, in English language, is the result of the masters' degree researches of the translators Diego Martins Pinto Guedes and Amanda Salimon, also students of the SLP-Audiology Graduate Program at University of São Paulo (FOB/USP Bauru), advised by Professor Regina Tangerino de Souza Jacob, Ph.D.


## Professor Regina Tangerino de Souza Jacob, Ph.D., Audiologist
